The Gilbert Room is located in the University Museum Complex, specifically on the first floor of the Museum of Comparative Zoology building at 26 Oxford Street. The room is marked **101A** on the door.

From Harvard Square:

The Harvard Museum of Natural History is approximately a ten-minute walk from the Harvard Square T stop on the Red Line. Upon exiting the Harvard Square T station through the Harvard Square exit, walk into Harvard Yard to the statue of John Harvard. From here, take the path to your left, exit the yard and veer diagonally right past the Science Center. This will take you to the intersection of Kirkland and Oxford streets. Follow Oxford Street to the left. The Museum of Comparative Zoology is located at 26 Oxford St. and is to the left of The Harvard Museum of Natural History. There is a set of stairs leading up to the front door. Inside the building take your first right and then right again in Agassiz, 101A.
